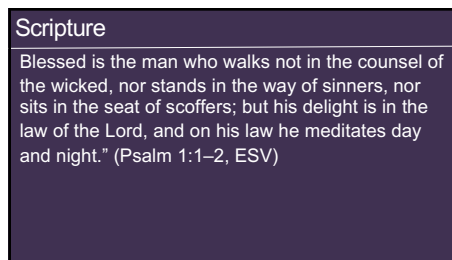

3. A Blessed person doesn't mock God's ways
 Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches. Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap." (Galatians 6:6–7, ESV)
